Materials You'll Need:

- Approximately 150 yards of medium weight yarn in your desired color
- Crochet hook size 4.0mm
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

- Fiberfill or yarn scraps for stuffing
- Embroidery floss or yarn for nose and whiskers (optional)
- Safety eyes (12mm or 9mm) (optional)

Step 1: Magic Ring (or Slip Knot)

Create a magic ring by wrapping the yarn around your index finger and making a loop. Insert the hook and pull up a loop through the center. Repeat this three more times to make a round of four loops.

Step 2: Single Crochet (sc)

Insert the hook into the next loop and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through both loops on the hook. You have now made a single crochet stitch. Repeat this process around the entire ring, crocheting 12 sc into the center.

Step 3: Increase Round

To create the cat's head shape, we will increase the number of stitches. Work 2 sc into the next loop, followed by 1 sc into the next loop. Repeat this pattern around the entire round, increasing twice in each loop.

Step 4: Head and Body

Continue crocheting sc around for 10 rounds. Then, work 2 sc into each loop around to shape the cat's head. Continue with 15 rounds of sc for the body.

Step 5: Ears

Create four ears by crocheting small ovals using the following pattern:

- Magic ring: 4 sc
- Round 2: 2 sc into each loop (8 sc)
- Round 3: 1 sc into each loop (8 sc)
- Round 4: 1 sc, 2 sc into next loop (10 sc)
- Round 5: 1 sc into each loop (10 sc)

Sew the ears to the head using yarn and a needle.

Step 6: Tail

Crochet a long, thin tail by crocheting sc in a chain stitch. Leave about 20-30 chains for a longer tail.

Step 7: Legs

Create four legs by crocheting the following pattern:

- Magic ring: 4 sc
- Round 2: 2 sc into each loop (8 sc)
- Round 3: 1 sc into each loop (8 sc)
- Round 4: (sc, 2 sc into next loop) repeat (10 sc)
- Round 5: (sc, sc, 2 sc into next loop) repeat (15 sc)
- Round 6-15: 1 sc into each loop (15 sc)
- Round 16: (sc, 2 sc into next loop) repeat (10 sc)
- Round 17: (sc, sc, 2 sc into next loop) repeat (15 sc)

- Round 18-25: 1 sc into each loop (15 sc)
- Round 26: (sc, dec, sc) repeat (10 sc)
- Round 27: (sc, dec) repeat (5 sc)
- Round 28: (dec) repeat (2 sc)
- Round 29: (sc) repeat (2 sc)
- Round 30: (dec) repeat (2 sc)
- Draw up the remaining yarn and close the hole.

Sew the legs to the body.

Step 8: Nose and Whiskers

For the nose, embroider a small triangle in black or pink yarn. For the whiskers, cut six strands of yarn about 6-8 inches long and thread them through the nose.

Step 9: Stuffing

Generously fill the cat with fiberfill or yarn scraps, leaving enough space to sew closed.

Step 10: Closing

Using a whipstitch, join the open edges of the cat's body together. Leave a small opening for the tail.

Step 11: Attaching the Tail

Insert the tail into the opening left in the body. Sew it in place securely.

Congratulations!

You have now crocheted a lovely cat! Enjoy your cuddly new companion.

- Use a dark yarn color for the nose to create a more realistic effect.
- Add a bow or collar to your cat for extra cuteness.


