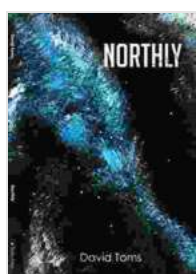


Early Life and Amateur Career

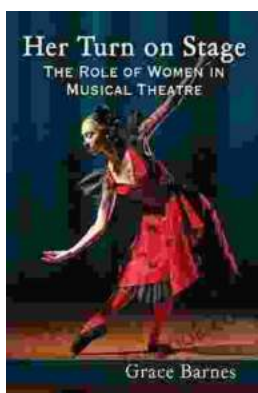

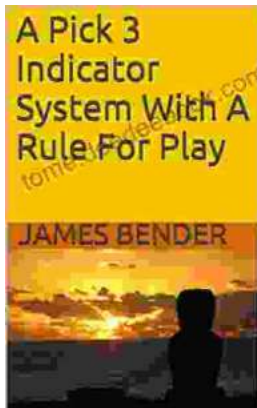
